# This year, the Department will initiate a process to revise the PF2050 national strategy

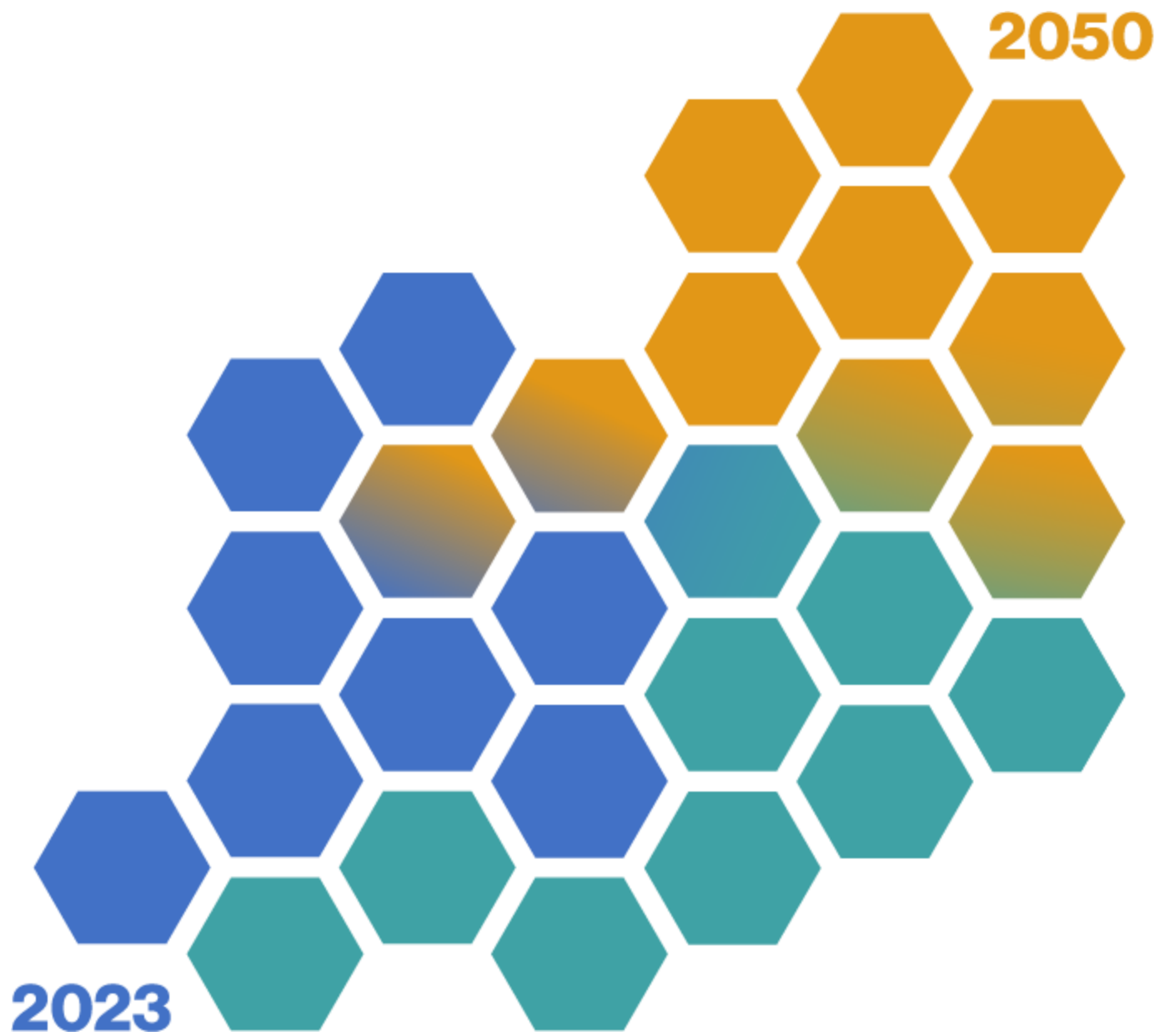
## *Purpose of the strategy*
